Today, we are ready to complete the campus redevelopment plan that began a decade ago, which included the construction of Manrell Hall and Lannon Hall. This \$14 million capital campaign, aptly called Encore, signifies the next chapter in Vancouver College's story. This campaign is more than a building—it's an investment in the creativity, confidence, and character of our students. This two-phased project begins with the construction of a 12,000-square-foot building at the corner of 38th Avenue and Cartier Street. Purpose-built for our flourishing music program, the facility will include spacious band rooms, dedicated rehearsal spaces, secure instrument storage, and a digital recording and media studio for our boys. The band rooms will feature 12-foot-high ceilings to ensure optimal acoustics and safer sound levels. This two-storey building will be significantly lower than both Lannon and Manrell Halls, preserving key sightlines. Its design will maintain harmony with the architectural aesthetic of the rest of our campus.

Once Phase One is complete in the Fall of 2027, we will proceed to Phase Two, which involves repurposing the vacated spaces to support co-curricular programs such as athletics, digital arts, and additional senior school classrooms, ensuring that every corner of our campus continues to serve the evolving needs of our students.
